ABOUT SANGATH Sangath is a non-governmental, not-for-profit organisation committed to improving health across the lifespan by empowering existing community resources to provide appropriate physical, psychological and social therapies. Its primary focus areas include child development, adolescent and youth health, and adult health and addictions research.

ABOUT THE PRIDE RESEARCH PROGRAMME This position is based in the PRIDE research programme in Goa, a Wellcome Trust-funded programme in India (Pl: Prof. Vikram Patel, Harvard Medical School) and is the largest adolescent mental health research programme ever undertaken in a low-and-middle-income (LMIC) country. PRIDE is currently four years into a five-year cycle that aims to establish a suite of psychological interventions for common adolescent mental health problems in India. The program is being implemented in Goa and New Delhi.

ABOUT THE POSITION We are looking for a dynamic, enthusiastic and motivated researcher interested in a research-cum-management role to join our interdisciplinary mental health team in Goa, India, to work on an RCT delivering a novel digital mental health intervention in low-resource schools. This is the first-of-a-kind study in India evaluating the efficacy of a smartphone app aimed at improving adolescent mental health. This intervention has been collaboratively developed with students in Goa and a leading international design-thinking company.

This role provides an opportunity to:

- gain experience of internationally driven high quality research
- be mentored by global mental health experts from Harvard Medical School and University of Sussex and collaborators at the University of Oxford and University of California Los Angeles (UCLA)
- develop project management skills

We are searching for someone who is interested in a team leadership role, who is proficient in qualitative and quantitative research methods and wants to make a contribution to an emerging high priority field of young people's mental health.

JOB DESCRIPTION

Research and analysis

- Responsible for conducting literature reviews and other relevant desk research
- Responsible for conducting qualitative interviews and focus group discussions
- Assist in data management, transcription and translation of qualitative data
- Contribute to analysis of qualitative and quantitative data in collaboration with the Data Manager

Trial management

- Responsible for providing line management and regular supervision team of up to 10 field staff
- Responsible for overseeing day-to-day roll-out of the RCT across multiple school sites
- Responsible for carrying out fidelity and quality checks
- Responsible for maintaining regular contact with other field teams (counsellors, data team, etc.)
